Emergency First Aid at Work

The Emergency First Aid at Work Course is ideal for Appointed Persons within an organisation, equipping them to respond effectively to medical emergencies. Upon completing this course, participants will be qualified to provide emergency first aid to individuals who become injured or unwell at work.

The course includes:

- Primary Survey: Danger Response Airway Breathing
- Anaphylaxis
- Asthma & Anxiety (Hyperventilation)
- Choking
- Chest Pain & Cardiac Arrest
- CPR & Defibrillation

The course runs for 6 hours, and lunch is included.

Eligibility:

This course is open to individuals working—paid or unpaid—for local charities or voluntary organisations.

All participants will receive a certificate valid for three years.



From M11 J7

Exit the M11 at Junction 7 and join the A414 Harlow Potter Street Bypass towards Harlow going through traffic lights (The Harlow Hotel). Remain on this road over next three roundabouts. At the fourth roundabout (Gates Garage on left) take the first exit onto Edinburgh Way (A414) going past Tesco on left. Continue over roundabout and turn right into Edinburgh Place (BP Petrol Station on the corner). Stephen Taylor House is located on the left.

From M11 J7a

Exit the M11 at Junction 7a follow slip road and take the right at the roundabout and straight over the next. At the third roundabout head onto the A1025 towards Harlow, going through traffic lights (Gilden Way). Continue straight at the fourth roundabout and then take a right at the fifth roundabout. At the sixth roundabout (Gates Garage on left) take the first exit onto Edinburgh Way (A414) going past Tesco on left. Continue over roundabout and turn right into Edinburgh Place (BP Petrol Station on the corner). Stephen Taylor House is located on the left.

From M25

Exit the M25 at Junction 27 and join the M11 towards Cambridge. Follow 'From M11 J7'.

From A10

Leave the A10 at the A414/Harlow slip road exit. Follow the A414 to the third roundabout and take the second exit to join Edinburgh Way (A414). Continue straight over two roundabouts, turn left into Edinburgh Place (BP Petrol Station on the corner). Stephen Taylor House is located on the left.

By Train
